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Planning Priority #1

To help students understand how to regulate their emotions and manage their behavior in ways that promote academic achievement, well-being and positive relationships.

Strategies;

- We will support/teach students to identify and regulate their emotions, using the Zones of Regulation program.
- Nurture positive relationships with a school wide check-in first thing in the morning, and a focus on effective listening/problem solving and repairing, when harm is done.
- We will use some grade specific resources such as Thrival Kits in grade 4, Little Dot in K, Second Step, etc as is most helpful.

Planning Priority #2

To create the conditions so students can progress at a rate of one year of growth for one year of teaching in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.

Strategies;

- Grade level cohorts collaborate to provide
 developmentally appropriate instruction to promote student
 academic achievement in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- All classes improve their ability to assess and teach for phonological and phonemic awareness, to improve Literacy skills.
- All teachers receive Math PD with Melo math 4 kids, to improve their understanding of effective Mathematics instruction.

Planning Priority #3

Explore ways to enable all stakeholders to experience "The Good Life". This includes students, staff and parents.

Strategies;

- Present components of "The Good Life" to all staff and parents for awareness, discussion and planning purposes.
- Consider ways to include parents in our school community so they also have a sense of partnership with South Oaks.
- Focus on how to live in relationship with others involved in the school and the broader local community.
